- Adoption of an anti-idling by-law

- Establishment of a preventative maintenance plan for all vehicles
- Environmental policy with responsible practices targeting an effective management of energy and consumables
- Progressive replacement of vehicles at the end of their useful lives with more fuel efficient models
- Promotion of domestic composting through the distribution of composters
- Promotion of carpooling among residents
- Active transportation corridor project
- Replacement of lighting with LEDs in municipal buildings
- Replacement of public lighting with LED streetlights
- Separation of the water collection networks (rain and sewer) on all new roadways
- Raise awareness among residents of better water management
- Grant for the purchase of low-flow shower heads
